

- Our ethos is very much that of a community based on Christian values.



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

- We also want to grow in the Christian virtues of truth, goodness, charity, loving kindness, joy, inner peace, and self control.




- When we, ourselves, are valued and appreciated we cannot help but pass this on to those around us.

- Striving for the best in ourselves and for others overflows into the community so that it is not just our school that is blessed, but the whole community.


